Scott County 2025 Certified Township Road Mileage – The board reviewed and agreed with what Scott County is giving us for road mileage. Motion by Ron and seconded by Les to approve with no changes. No further discussion. Motion carried by all. Mona will mail the form back.

Met Council – 2025 System Statements – informational purposes only.

2025 Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) Application – Ted stated that we should submit an application to try and get funding for the Park Blvd. hill. Ted will follow-up with Scott County to see if they can assist in completing an application again. Keep on the agenda for November's meeting.

2025 Polling Place Accessibility Grant application – board thought our access was fine for accessibility so we will not pursue this.

Old Business:

City of Jordan update:

190th Street update — Round-a-bout is open for a short period of time. The round-a-bout will be completely closed going to Jordan sometime in the near future for 2 years or until the overpass is complete.

Children at Play signs at 218th and Shelby – This has been completed. Thank you to Randy at Scott County Highway. Both signs are up and nothing negative being said. This can come off the agenda.

City of Belle Plaine update – No update. There is a school referendum. Also had gotten the Belle Plaine Rural Fire Protection Association information. They are talking about disbanding this. The meeting on October $21^{\rm st}$ will be to review and discuss all options. Ted and Ron will be going to this meeting to get the information.

MN DOT Update – Request from Jolene at Suzette, Inc. to get the signs up now that the road is done so people know how to get to their businesses. Ron stated that he tried to talk to Robert Wagner at the last meeting about plowing the road to his business and Robert pretty much avoided the conversation. Ron had issues with our township having to plow this without owning the road and also we have no place to turn around except to on personal property. Ted said Robert has some concerns about the road and if US Fish and Wildlife would get it would it remain open. At this time, it was determined that if it snows, the township will not plow.

Road Maintenance Report — Todd did a lot of stuff in the last month. Roads have all been patched, 214th complete, the tree by John Sable's is now out and complete. John was present and wanted to thank the township for what they did with the tree. Todd is now working on other areas of the township's ditches on Park Blvd. The ditch by Caola's needs to be cleaned out also. Ted stated new signs were also put up in Sioux Vista, Township #57 and a few others. The west end of 195th St to the other end is the next project. Sioux Vista brush needs to be done yet also.
